

RESOLUTION

High Priority Corridors

WHEREAS, Section 72-2-117 of the Utah Code Annotated 2006, as amended, directs the Transportation Commission to administer the Transportation Corridor Preservation Revolving Loan Fund to preserve transportation corridors, promote long-term statewide transportation planning, and save on acquisition costs; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission is further directed to designate high priority corridor preservation projects in cooperation with a metropolitan planning organization.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved the list of high priority corridors for preservation follows:

Salt Lake	SR-154 (Bangerter Highway)	I-15 to I-80, existing intersections only
Salt Lake/Utah	SR-85 (Mountain View Corridor)	From I-80 to I-15 and SR-73 in Utah County
Utah	SR-176 (Vineyard Connector)	Intersection of SR-52 and SR-114 in Orem to SR-145 in American Fork
Washington	SR-9	I-15 to 520 West - Hurricane
Washington	SR-7 (Southern Corridor)	I-15 to SR-59
Washington	SR-18	St. George Boulevard to St. George City Limits
