

# RESOLUTION 2016 - 01

## **Amended High Priority Corridors**

**WHEREAS**, under Section 72-5-402 of the Utah Code, the Legislature finds and declares that the planning and preservation of transportation corridors is a public purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 72-5-403 of the Utah Code directs the Utah Transportation Commission to designate transportation corridors as high priority transportation corridors for corridor preservation purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Commission adopted a High Priority Corridor List in April 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, additional high priority corridors will be added and deleted by this resolution;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved the list of high priority corridors be amended to delete SR-252 (1000 West), add SR-37 (1800 North), and make minor modifications to the existing routes as follows:

### **AMENDED HIGH PRIORITY CORRIDOR LIST**

Davis/Weber	SR-108 [MP 4-13]	Syracuse/Antelope to SR-126
Salt Lake	SR-154 (Bangerter) [MP 0-24]	I-15 to I-80
Salt Lake/Utah	SR-85 (MVC) [MP 0-34]	From I-15 and SR-73 to I-80
Washington	SR-9 [MP 0-9]	I-15 to 520 West – Hurricane
Washington	SR-7 [MP 0-22]	I-15 to SR-9
Washington	SR-18 [MP 2-5]	St. George Boulevard to City Limit
Utah	SR-176 (Vineyard Connector)	Intersection of SR-52 and SR-114 in Orem to SR-145 in American Fork
