Purpose

This policy establishes a high priority transportation corridor approval procedure that the Utah Transportation Commission (UTC) shall follow.

Policy

This policy is pursuant to UTC authority to make policies necessary to perform UTC duties described under Utah Transportation Code § 72-1-303.

Background

Utah Transportation Code § 72-5-402 declares that the planning and preservation of transportation corridors is a public purpose. Further, Utah Transportation Code § 72-5-403(3) directs the UTC to designate transportation corridors as high priority transportation corridors for transportation corridor preservation purposes.

Definitions

High Priority Corridor – Corridors approved by the Utah Transportation Commission as a high priority transportation corridor for transportation corridor preservation purposes, pursuant to department policy.

Procedures

Resolution

UTC 01-05.1

The UTC through resolution shall amend, add or remove designated high priority transportation corridors.

The resolution shall include recommendations identified by the Utah Department of Transportation for amendment, addition to or removal from the list of designated high priority transportation corridors, as well as a current list of UTC approved high priority transportation corridors.

A copy of the approved resolution shall be sent to counties and municipalities in which the high priority transportation corridors are designated.
