Lines 126 – 128:

(xvi) \$10,000,000 to the Transportation Fund to pay all or part of the costs of state and federal highway construction or reconstruction projects as prioritized by the Transportation Commission.

Recommendation:

\$6,149,000

I-15 Northbound, 10600 South Interchange Improvements - Off-Ramp Tunnel into South Town Mall. This project is included in the Chokepoint Projects List prioritized and recommended for funding for 2016. *The timing of the funding for this project will move it up into the 2014 List.*

Concept from the North-South Study; Alternative #8A: A NB exit lane will be added to the 10600 South off-ramp, that travels directly to the South Towne Mall parking lot. The new lane will travel under the existing 10600 South roadway, through a box culvert structure. The existing dual right turn lanes will be restriped to a single right turn lane. The project will consist of constructing new pavement, a new box culvert structure, new striping, and cast-in-place concrete barrier to address clear zone requirements.

The preliminary pavement section consists of 11" Portland-Cement Concrete Pavement, 4" open graded base course, 6" untreated base course, and 15" granular borrow.
